How do adults learn?


Research has shown that over 72 hours adults retain...

- √ 10% of what they read
- ✓ 20% of what they hear
- √ 30% of what they see
- √ 50% of what they see and hear
- √ 70% of what they say
- √ 90% of what they say & do

Trainer Responsibilities

- · You MUST want to be there, be passionate
- Respect your audience & adapt to their experience and knowledge
- Be prepared you must be very familiar with your topic





Trainer Responsibilities



- Make it relevant
 - find examples, articles, employees that have experienced your subject - tie in off the job activities
- · Be honest don't be a know it all
- Employ Fun & Humor
- · Plan activities get them involved
